



Our Clubfoot Creek Event will be Saturday, October 4, 2013, but please feel free to arrive on Friday, October 3. There is good anchorage as well as great kayaking on Clubfoot Creek, so you can find things to do. There will be a potluck at the home of Kathy Long and Peter Gauthier on Saturday, October 4, and we will come by dinghy and ferry boaters to the dock starting at 4:15. Happy hour that day will be at 4:30 and dinner will be at 5:30. Please bring your own drinks and a dish to share. For those of you who cannot come by boat, you can come via land. Call us for directions. We hope to have Happy Hour outdoors, so you might need a light jacket.

Clubfoot Creek is located off the Neuse River, more or less across from, and south of, Oriental. Follow the markers in, being careful to stay in the channel. Once you are inside the Creek, stay in the middle as you make your way towards our community dock. You will pass Mitchell Creek and Matthews Point Marina on the west. You will also pass private docks on both sides of the river. The community dock is the largest and is on the west shore. Even though it is the largest dock, there are usually only 3 or 4 boats there. You can safely anchor in the creek both up and down river from our dock. Please refer to the 2 attached charts. We marked an area for anchoring on the Clubfoot Creek chart. We are looking forward to seeing you!
