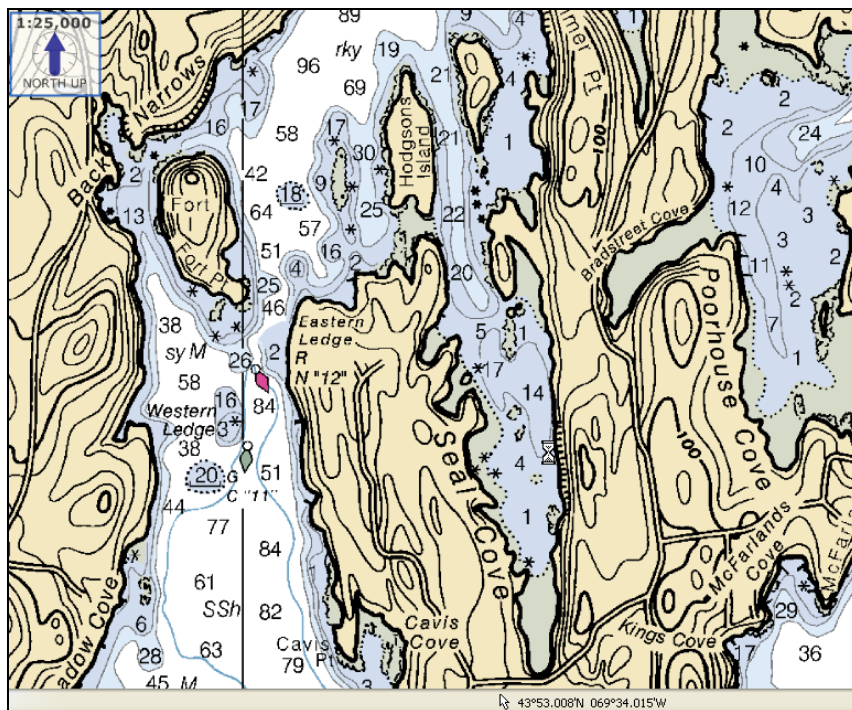

Please join us aboard *Solmar* for a Float-In at Seal Cove along the Damariscotta River. In the evening we'll gather on one or more boats or ashore on the sandbar South of Hodgsons Island for a pot-luck dinner. Come prepared with something to share.

This will be a casual gathering of Cape Dorys and friends in one of our favorite spots along the Midcoast. Anchor anywhere in the center of the channel in 20 to 22 feet of water shown on the chartlet below. If you proceed deep into Seal Cove, watch for the ledges that are awash at high tide in the area between the 5 and 17 foot depths on the chartlet below. You may want to explore the rest of Seal Cove in your dinghy. Please note the current running through *The Narrows* in the Damariscotta River can be strong at times, High Tide is at 2:33 pm on the 11th and Low Tide is at 8:56 am on the 12th.

***Fleet communications will be on VHF Ch. 16 and 68.
Please monitor these channels during the event.
